Student Conduct

1. I will come to school.

7. I will listen to my teacher. After three warnings, I will meet with the Principal. After two meetings with the Principal, I will participate in the class with my guardian.

2. I will greet teachers "안녕하세요?" and friends "안녕?"
3. I will stay in my seat
4. I will turn in my homework and take out my textbook

In the class,

1. **Before I leave**, I will focus on the instruction
2. I will sit correctly
3. I will speak in Korean
4. I will keep my hands to myself
5. I will keep my hands off other people's things
6. I will respect others
7. Before I leave I will say "안녕히 계세요." to my teacher and "안녕, 다음 주에 만나." to my friends

At home,

1. I will do my homework
2. I will read a Korean book for 15 minutes everyday
3. I will write my journal in Korean
4. With my parent's permission, I will watch Korean videos from website recommended by my teachers.
